OUR MINISTRY

OUR WEEKLY PROGRAMS

PRESCHOOL | SUNDAYS AT 8:30AM, 10AM AND 11:30AM

Our preschool and nursery ministry is offered for birth - age 4. These classes create a loving and safe environment for your child to learn basic foundational truths from the Bible. These classes include:

Little Rabbits: Birth - 18 months

Little Foxes: 18 months - 35 months

Little Bears: 3 years - 4 years (must be potty trained)

ELEMENTARY | SUNDAYS AT 8:30AM, 10AM AND 11:30AM

Our Elementary Ministry is for 5 years - 4th grade. Kids gather in KidsPoint for large group to worship, pray, play games, and hear the lesson and then are separated into small groups by age/grade for age specific learning. Our grades are split into 3 categories: **5 year olds & Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade, and 3rd & 4th grade.**

BUDDIES | SUNDAYS AT 8:30AM, 10AM & 11:30AM

The Buddies program exists to partner with families to give the support a child with special needs deserves so they can participate either in our specialized buddies room or in an age-appropriate LifePoint Kid's classroom with a Buddy by their side, while their parents attend church.

CHILDCARE | SUNDAYS AT 10AM & 11:30AM

Childcare is offered for age 5 - 4th grade for kids whose parents attend and serve both services.

THE FINE PRINT

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

CHECK-IN

To make your first visit as easy as possible, we have created both an online and in-person registration process for you and your family. During registration, we'll get to know things like how many children are in your family, what allergies your child(ren) may have, and the best way to contact you. Once you are registered and checked in, both you and your child(ren) will receive a set of stickers with a matching code, also known as a "security tag". On the tag, you will also find your child's corresponding room. This sticker is what you'll use to pick up your child after the service. **If, for any reason, we need to reach you, we will text the number on your child's account.**

DROP OFF & PICK UP

Once your child(ren) are checked in and arrive at the room printed on their sticker, our leaders will be ready to greet your family and engage your child in an age-appropriate activity. At the end of the service, a team member will verify that your security tag code matches the code on your child's tag before he/she is released into your care. In the event of a lost sticker, we will use your driver's license as an alternative to the security tag to verify information and check out your child.

SAFETY

In LifePoint Kids, we are committed to safety, and it is the heart of our children's ministry to make every effort to ensure the safety and well-being of every child.

With this in mind, all team members serving in a LifePoint Kids area go through a screening process before serving. All team members serving are background-checked and trained in safety and security protocols.

Once in our care, a child is not allowed to be picked up by anyone who does not have a sticker with the code that coincides with the one on his/her sticker. If a security tag has been lost, photo identification must be presented and matched with the guardian information on the registered account. If a need arises or you have any questions, please contact a staff member and they will be happy to assist you.

WE CONSIDER ALLERGIES

Due to the risk of allergies, we do not allow outside foods in the classrooms, and we are a peanut free facility.

If your child has a medical need or allergy, please make sure you add it to the check-in system so it prints on your child's name tag every week. Plus, let the leader and a member of our check-in team know. We cannot administer any medications. When food and drink are used in our children's ministry rooms, an allergy alert sign will be posted.

SMALL GROUPS

We are a church of Small Groups, and this starts with our kids.

In LifePoint Kids services, your children will be taught grade-specific, biblical truths and practical lessons through a learning plan and collection of series topics throughout the year.

Each week in their Small Group, they will work together on learning objectives like memorizing Scripture and understanding biblical principles.

Series topics will be presented through a video Bible lesson, followed by an age-specific, guided discussion and activities with their Small Group.

OUR KIDS SERVICES INCLUDE:

Praise and Worship

We invite God's presence into our lives through praise and worship, and we want your child(ren) to grow up experiencing the joy and benefit of worshipping Him.

Making Friends

God designed us for community, and we want your kids to build healthy relationships with other kids their age. Making friends is an important part of their spiritual growth.

Age - Specific Learning

Kids have different needs at different ages, and we want to help your child understand and learn God's Word at the right pace.

Consistent Small Group Leadership

We want your kids to look forward to seeing a familiar face at church each week. As they build a relationship with their Small Group Leader, we hope they'll share, ask questions, and feel supported and cared for as they grow in their faith.

Memorizing God's Word

God tells us to hide His Word in our hearts (Psalm 119:11 NIV). One of the most important ways we help your children build a biblical foundation for their lives is by filling their minds and hearts with God's Truth through Scripture memorization.
